  - All Faculties provide a high quality university education in accredited study programmes in all three levels of study – Bachelor, Master and Doctoral.



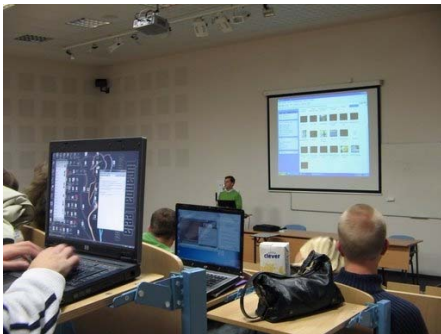
- **Bachelor degree study programmes:**

- **Master degree study programmes:**
  - Law (with the focus on European and international law)
  - Economy and International Business Management
  - Mass Media Communication
  - Marketing Communication
- **Doctoral / PhD. study programmes:**
  - Theory and History of State and Law
  - Criminal Law
  - International Law
  - Economy and International Business Management
  - Mass Media Studies





- BSL is a higher education institution emphasizing its international orientation - outstanding academics from Slovakia as well as university professors and scholars from the Czech Republic, Austria, Germany, France and the Russian Federation are involved in the teaching process. The courses are taught in Slovak, Czech, English and German.

- Master study programmes at all Faculties have international orientation and most courses are run in foreign languages.
- BSL in accordance with its award of the European University Charter (EUC) gives its students the opportunity to take part in mobility study programmes at 16 partner universities in the EU.



- Study at BSL is realised in its modern premises offering 21<sup>st</sup> century education standards including the use of latest information technologies.

### Centre for Language and Academic Preparation (CLAP)

- is a language centre of BSL specialized in teaching foreign languages to its students.
- The CLAP main goal is **to teach foreign languages** (English, German, French, Italian, Spanish, Russian) to BSL students in their full-time as well as part-time study within a widely recognized university certification system for foreign language programs UNICert®.



- CLAP is also specialized in teaching **Slovak as a foreign language** to international students before their university studies in Slovakia as well as other foreigners in various full-time and part-time study programmes - intensive daily courses, evening classes, one-to-one lessons, tailor-made courses, Summer School of the Slovak Language and Culture.



- CLAP also provides examinations assessing the Slovak language proficiency with the possibility to receive a certificate of the language proficiency on the levels B1, B2 or C1 in accordance with the Common European Network of Reference for Languages.

*CLAP is specialized in teaching Slovak for foreigners.*

*It provides Foundation programmes as an intensive language and academic preparation to international students before their studies at BSL or other universities in Slovakia.*

These full-time study programmes last one academic year (October - May):

- **Foundation programme A** - 700 lessons of the Slovak language.
- **Foundation programme B** – 960 lessons; i.e. 700 lessons of the Slovak language + 260 lessons of English.
- **Foundation programme C** – 960 lessons; i.e. 700 lessons of the Slovak language plus 180 lessons of English plus 40 + 40 consultation lessons in 2 profile subjects.

After completing these programmes it is possible to pass the examination assessing the Slovak language competency and receive the certificate on the level B2. The graduates are prepared for entrance exams at any Slovak university.



- **Slovak language course No. I** - duration: 3-months (240 lessons)  
- starting in October, February
- **Slovak language program No. II** – duration: 5 months (400 lessons)  
- starting in October, February
- **Evening classes of the Slovak language**  
- duration: 3-months (44 - 48 lessons)  
- starting in September, January, April
- **Summer School of the Slovak language and culture**  
- duration: 3 weeks (90 lessons)  
- in July
